# HOW TO ENTER

Please label the image file with your name and category but please **don't** show your name on the photograph itself.



Only one image per entry should be sent and taken with the garment placed against a white background on a hanger or worn by the entrant, with the exception of the 3R's category where we would like to see a **'before'** and **'after'** image.

**All competitors will receive an entry acknowledgement which includes a '2 for 1' discount code to share with family and friends. Every finalists in each category will also receive a complimentary ticket to visit the show.**

# HOW THE COMPETITION WILL WORK

After the closing date (**Friday 28th January, 2022**), the 10 shortlisted finalists from each category will be required to post their entry to ICHF Events by **Friday 25th February, 2022** at the latest.

Shortlisted entrants will be contacted by daytime telephone number or email to arrange for the garment to be sent in to: ICHF Events, Dominic House, Seaton Road, Highcliffe, Dorset, BH23 5HW.

A special 'Sew Your Style' exhibit of all the finalists will be displayed for visitors to admire at **Sewing for Pleasure** between **17th-20th March 2022**.

The top 10 shortlisted entries will be judged on the FIRST day of the show on **Thursday 17th March 2022** and announced via social media after the judging has finished. Awards will be given for **1st, 2nd** and **3rd** in each of the categories plus an overall Judges Choice. While judging takes place, there will be no access to the area.

The winners' garments will be shown on the **Sewing for Pleasure Catwalk** on **Sunday 20th March 2022** in the afternoon, and garments can be collected after the show from The Sew Your Style exhibit stand.
